

## RE: Update - Spring 2 Mock Period

As promised in my previous letter before half term, I write to provide further details regarding the spring mock period. Please ensure your daughter has read this letter very carefully as it outlines key information she will need for a smooth examination window.

The government announced on 22<sup>nd</sup> February that schools will open from 8<sup>th</sup> March, however this will also need to include whole school Covid-testing before school doors are fully open to face-to-face teaching for students. These rapid Covid-tests need to occur 3-5 days apart which affects the next few weeks and have to be administered 3 times. To ensure there is no further delay to the March mock period these originally postponed examinations will continue to go ahead with students sitting these remotely from home, in this study leave period, using the Inspera platform as planned.



It is also worth noting, one of the outcomes of the joint Ofgual and Department of Education consultation regarding centre-assessed-grades (CAGS) is that teachers will use a range of evidence to arrive at CAGS, therefore we will have another formal assessment period in May/June. This is to ensure students have more opportunity to evidence their ability in each subject they are currently taking with the benefit of this being closer to the end of each of their courses. As long as the school continues to be open the expectation is these will be sat at school in the usual examination manner. I will be in touch in due course to summarise the outcomes of the full consultation and how this impacts your daughter in terms of assessment procedures going forward.

## Spring mock examination windows:

Year 12 students who are not sitting any AS exams in this mock period will be expected to return to face to face teaching on 8th March, once they have had their Covid test. The schedule of Covid testing will be released shortly by Mrs Hayden, the Headteacher.





























#### Ahead of the March mock examination period:

- It's your daughter's responsibility to ensure she can log in successfully and she should take some time to become familiar with the software ahead of her assessments. Any log-in issues should be reported. Please see the 'setting up Inspera' section.
- Your daughter needs access to a laptop/computer device to complete her mocks.
   She <u>should not</u> take these assessments using a mobile phone. If circumstances have changed and your daughter no longer has access to the internet or a suitable electronic device please contact me as a matter of urgency.
- If your daughter is using a DfE loaned laptop, there are restrictions placed on the
  device by the DfE which will impact access to the software. Those students
  currently with a DfE laptop will be emailed separately about preparing for the
  mocks.
- Your daughter should check her mock timetable very carefully (at the end of this letter) to ensure she is clear when her assessments will take place. <u>Mock examinations that are missed for any reason (technical issues/absence etc.) will not be able to be re-sat at a later date.</u> Unfortunately under the current circumstances this is something we are unable to facilitate.

## Setting up Inspera

- Student log-ins have been set up for use on Inspera this is the same as your daughter's school Gmail log-in details.
- By Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> March please ensure she has visited the following link: <a href="https://nmbec.inspera.com/">https://nmbec.inspera.com/</a> and check she can successfully log in.
- She should sit the Practice Test to become familiar with the system:
  - Click on 'register' under the question Do you have a test code? Then complete the 'practice test'.
  - The first time she uses Inspera she will need to download 'lockdown browser'. Please ensure she does this when prompted (usually 15minutes). Once this is download she will not be required to do this again it will be ready for whenever she sits a mock.
  - o Once this is downloaded to her device she can sit the practice test.
  - She will then be asked for a SEB code. Please enter: nmbec 2021for all mock exams. For the practice test students need to use NMBEC2021 (capitals)
  - As long as she has been able to sit this practice test and continues to have internet connection she is ready for her mock exams.
- As Inspera has enhanced security parameters such as the lockdown browser
  with additional checks for plagiarism combined with in-test monitoring of your
  daughter's responses while sitting her exams, webcams do not need to be turned
  on. Student mobile phones should be turned off and out of reach.
- Before every mock exam your daughter will have to declare she is sitting the
  mock in exam conditions. Please ensure your daughter completes her mocks in
  silence, with no other materials other than those permitted and in a space she will
  not be distracted. If a student is found to have breeched this declaration in order
  to seek an unfair advantage during her mocks, this will have serious
  consequences and may result in disqualification from her course/s.

#### Important notes:

- Students who have are entitled to an access arrangement will still be contacted in a separate letter to discuss how this can be accommodated.
- As you can appreciate, grades can only be assigned if work is completed. If your daughter fails to complete an assessment this will be recorded as not completed.
- During the mocks periods set out there will be no live lessons, instead the time should be used by students to revise and prepare for their examinations.
- Inspera enables enhanced plagiarism checks. If a student is found to have plagiarised any of their work this will be automatically be flagged by the software and the student will receive an automatic U grade and the appropriate sanctions carried out.
- In order to facilitate moderation of the assessment sat across year groups, Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> March and Friday 19<sup>th</sup> March will be half school days as staff need to moderate marking.

## **Support**

- To further support your daughter through her mock period we have reduced the number of papers she will sit compared to what was previously planned.
- For sixth form we have spread the mock exams over a larger number of days than was initially planned should these have been sat in school.
- Where possible, we have included a weekend in the schedule to provide some relief between papers.
- Some subjects have opted for students to sit partial papers rather than full mock papers.
- The school has moved remote assessment to the Inspera platform instead of Google Classroom, which will provide your daughter with a much smoother experience of remote assessments.
- An Inspera practice paper has been made available so students can have a good sense of the system ahead of their mocks. Step-by-step instructions will be provided.
- Additional time (10%) has been added to all remote exams in recognition this is a different way of working for students.
