Dear Parent/Carer,

KS4 & KS5 Saturday School and Easter School Revision Workshops

We are pleased to offer Year 11 and 13 students a structured programme of GCSE revision sessions at Norbury High on Saturdays in the Spring term and in the forthcoming Easter holiday period. I attach a copy of the programme of revision sessions to this letter for your information.

Class sizes in the revision sessions will be limited to 24 students and the sessions will concentrate on the specific topics outlined on the attached programme. Attendance to any workshops or sessions on a Saturday or in the Easter break are not compulsory but we believe that many students would benefit from focussed revision on key topics at this stage ahead of their exams.

Each day is divided into 2 sessions (morning and afternoon of 2 hours) and within these sessions there will be a variety of different revision classes offered. Each session will be taught by a subject specialist.

Students can attend a maximum of 2 revision sessions per day and will need to look at the subjects and topics being offered within each session in order to make the most appropriate choice to meet their own specific revision needs. Subject teachers can also advise on the most beneficial sessions for each student to attend.

Please note that teachers are not required to run revision sessions on Saturdays or in school holidays; the schedule reflects staff who have volunteered to run sessions during this period.

In order to run the sessions, we need to charge an amount per class. We have also subsidised the cost of the revision classes for any students who are either currently in receipt of free school meals, have received free school meals in the last 6 years or who are Looked After.

The cost to attend these sessions is as follows:

Cost	Cost for students who are Looked After or who are entitled to Free School Meals
£10 a 2 hour workshop	£5 a 2 hour workshop

If you would like your daughter to take advantage of the booster classes being offered at Norbury High, then please do the following:

1. Complete the online booking form here: <https://forms.gle/4Xk3cTGp82N1tLf57>
2. Make the appropriate payment on Arbor Pay

Once both of the actions above are completed your daughter's schedule will be confirmed. As the booking system is all completed online via Google forms, sign up is first come, first served and paid for. Class sizes are capped at 24 students so once this number is reached your daughter may be contacted if the session is full to change her choice.

The deadline to complete the online booking form and make payment is Thursday 26th March

Once all forms and payments have been processed payment becomes non-refundable.


Notes for students, Parents and Carers:

- Students are not required to wear school uniforms on these days but should be appropriately dressed.
- Students are expected to be punctual to their revision classes. (If they arrive more than 10 minutes late without prior notice they will be refused entry and will not be offered a refund.
- There are two session slots a day, each two hours in length: 9:00-11:00am and 11:45-1:45pm.
- Students will be expected to come equipped appropriately for the sessions they will take e.g. calculators, writing equipment etc.
- There will not be a canteen service during the revision period so students will need to bring a packed lunch/food for the break sessions if they are booked for the day.
- Please note, if there is any misbehaviour from students they will be sent home immediately; lateness and misbehaviour cause disruption and this valuable revision time needs to be protected.

I hope you will encourage your daughter to take advantage of the booster sessions on offer. If you require any clarification then please do not hesitate to contact Ms Patel who is coordinating the Easter school this academic year.
