RE: Yr 13 Summer Exam Series Update

I write to confirm that the main summer exam series begins for year 13 on Tuesday 7th May 2024 and the exam window runs until Wednesday 26th June. All students must be available up until Wednesday 26th June should an exam board visit occur and they are requested, particularly if they have completed coursework/NEA or controlled assessments as part of their course.

Students in year 13 are due to finish face-to-face teaching at Norbury High School on **Friday 3rd May** (students should attend P1 & 2 lessons on Friday 3rd as normal). There will be a Leavers assembly at 11:15am that day.

From Tuesday 7th May students are only required to attend school if they have an exam <u>or</u> if a specific subject has requested a lesson to go ahead as normal. This may be because the lesson falls right before the actual exam for that subject or if elements of the course need further guided study with teacher direction in these final weeks. If this is the case, the class teacher will make a formal announcement on Google Classroom; the lesson is recognised as compulsory and a register will be taken.

During the exam series the sixth form study space or the school library is available for students to use for revision 08:55 am-1:15pm. It is of paramount importance that they have signed in using their school ID card — regular checks will be made to ensure those using the space have signed in. This is for health and safety purposes; if a student has not signed in they will be asked to leave the school premises. **Unless they are in an exam, all Yr 13 students should be off site by 1:15pm.**

Results day is scheduled for Thursday 15th August morning; further details regarding arrangements for collecting results will be released toward the end of the academic year.

I would like to take this opportunity to wish all our students the very best in their exams and next steps and I look forward to seeing them on results day.
