KS5 Business

The A level courses provide students with access to a broad range of business knowledge through real businesses case studies and current news examples. Students will sit AQA A Level Business at the end of year 13 or an AS option. The course is delivered by starting with the nature and purpose of Business to provide a foundation for students who may not have studied the subject at GCSE. The topics are broadly independent of each other throughout the course.

Year 12

- 1. The nature and purpose of business
- 2. Managers, Leadership and decision making
- 3. Decision making to improve marketing performance
- 4. Decision making to improve operational performance
- 5. Decision making to improve financial performance
- 6. Decision making to improve human resource performance

Year 13

- Analysing the strategic position of a business internally and through the external environment
- 2. Analysing investment appraisal
- 3. Choosing strategic direction on which markets to compete in and what products to offer
- 4. How to pursue strategies and assessing; a change in scale, innovation, internalisation and greater use of technology
- 5. Managing strategic change through the organisational culture and strategic implementation
- 6. The problems with strategy and why it fails.
