ENERGY/RESOURCES

- Switch off all lights, computers and appliances when they are not being used
- Walk, cycle or take the bus to school
- Don't leave taps running or dripping
- Turn down the temperature on your central heating/hot water and washing machine
- Wear something warm in cold weather
- Cut food waste by planning carefully, and not buying food we can't finish

LITTER AND WASTE

- Never drop litter and use the recycling bins provided
- Buy products in bulk and with less plastic packaging and take sustainable shopping bags
- Avoid single use plastic items such as cups and water bottles products at school. You can recycle 'stretchy' plastic bags at larger supermarkets.
